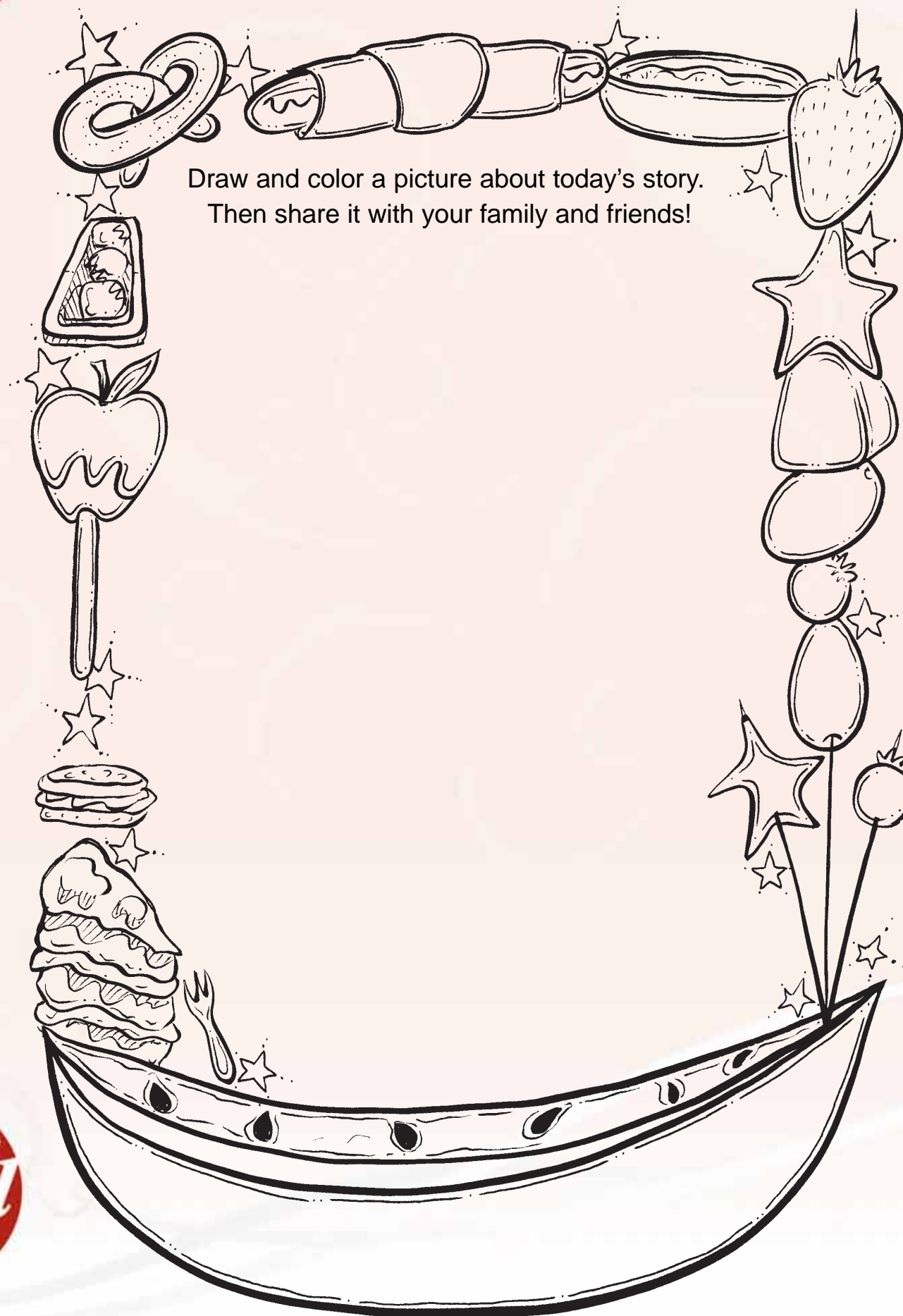
## Do This!
